The towels are given to the senior woman teacher who distributes them to pupils in case of immediate need and this will make the pupil to attend classes normally and achieve their educational goals. These sanitary towels were distributed to three primary schools in Papoli village and both the pupils and teachers of these schools thanked the organization for coming to their rescue.

Last week community development department was on a drive of protecting and cleaning all water sources in Papoli village. This village is very blessed because it has the most water sources in any one particular village in the entire country and this blessing requires protection so that it can benefit those in existence now and those to come in future.

Community development has formed water user committees whose members are elected for each particular water source and these are charged with the responsibility of mobilizing residents if need be to come together clean and even protect the water source. The committee heads collect a minimal fee from those who use these water sources which is then used to repair the water sources in case of any damage.
